## **IGPA President Scott Brown to Testify at Congressional Field Hearing in Idaho**

**BOISE, Apr. 27, 2010** – Soda Springs grain producer and Idaho Grain Producers Association (IGPA) President Scott Brown is set to testify at a field hearing Saturday of the U.S. House of Representatives Committee on Agriculture.

Chairman Collin Peterson and Members of the Agriculture Committee are hosting a field hearing in Nampa, Idaho on Saturday, May 1. The hearing will focus on reauthorization of the Farm Bill and will be held in the Old Science Lecture Hall on the Northwest Nazarene University campus beginning at 1:00pm.

Testimony is by invitation only and is being arranged by the Committee, but the hearing is open to the public. President Scott Brown will provide testimony on behalf of Idaho's wheat and barley producers.

The Farm Bill ensures that all Americans have access to a safe, secure and inexpensive food supply and provides a safety net for farmers and ranchers. It also authorizes important nutrition programs, encourages environmentally friendly conservation programs, and supports the development of agriculturally based renewable energy.
