Dear Director Thiel,

With over 600 wheat and barley farm families as members, the Idaho Grain Producers Association (IGPA) is the key policy advocacy organization working on behalf of Idaho's grain industry with local, state, and federal leaders. Considering the impact that recent diseases have had on cereal crops, directly related to the extended growing season, our growers would benefit from increased flexibility of their fall planting date as a management tool. On behalf of Idaho's grain growers, we request that the Risk Management Agency change the fall planting date in the following counties:

Bannock Bingham Blaine Bonneville Cassia Gooding Jerome Minidoka Power Twin Falls

All of these counties have a final planting date under the Winter Coverage Endorsement of October 15, with the exception of Bonneville County, which has a final planting date of September 30. There is overwhelming consensus that a final planting date of October 30 would be more appropriate in these counties, given changes in climate over time and disease prevalence.
